What is My Care?



You can use My Care on your computer, tablet or mobile phone.

My Care is a Patient Portal.

It lets you safely see **some** of your health information online.

For example

- medications
- treatments
- things you are allergic to.

My Care also lets you

- reply to messages from health and care teams
- look at some test results
- look at appointment information and
- see letters about your health and care.



My Care is free.

You can choose to use it or not.



Nothing will change if you do not want to use My Care

We will keep sending you letters, text reminders and calling you.



Who can use My Care



You can use My Care if you are

 over 18 years old and can make decisions for yourself or



 under 18 years old and a health and social care professional has agreed you can use My Care.

Support to use your My Care



You can choose to let someone you trust support you to use your My Care. For example, family or staff.

This is called **proxy access**.



Letting someone use your My Care allows them to support you.

For example

- to look at and get ready for appointments
- to read and understand your letters.



You can stop anyone using your My Care at any time. It is your choice.

You choose how much other people can see and do on your My Care.

You can change this at any time.

Supporting someone to use My Care



Talk to a health and social care professional if you are supporting someone who is

- over 18 years old and cannot make decisions for themselves or
- a child or young person.

Health and social care professionals will decide

- if you can use someone else's My Care to support them
- and how much you can see and do on it.

They will talk with you if they feel they need to look into changing their decision.



Being allowed to use a My Care account that is not your own is called being given **Proxy Access**

If you are using a mobile phone or tablet



To get My Care you need to download and open the MyChart App from

- App store or
- Google Play.





You can start to use My Care when

- you use a Trust service and
- that Trust is using **encompass**.



For example

You may be a Western Trust patient but need to get cancer treatment in Belfast City Hospital. If the Belfast Trust has encompass then you will be able to get My Care.



encompass is a new computer programme that will put your health and social care information in one place online.

All Trusts in Northern Ireland will use it.

To keep your health information safe you have

- a username
- a password
- and two step verification.



Two step verification means your account stays safe even if someone else has your username or password.

It sends you a code that you can type into My Care to see your health information.



If you are not using My Care for 10 minutes or more you will need to type in your username and password again.

This helps keep your information safe.



What you can do

- 1. Keep your password private.
- 2. Close My Care if you need to leave your computer, phone or tablet.

It is good to change your password often. For example, every 3-6 months.



Using My Care

How to find my appointments



When appointments are booked or changed you get

- an email or
- message on your mobile phone or tablet.



Go to My Care and click on Messages.



Click on Visits to see your appointments.

Go to **Letters** to find any information you have been sent about your medical team.

How do I see my test results?



Go to My Care and click on **Test Results**.



You can see some test results.

For example

- Covid-19 tests
- Blood pressure tests
- Cholesterol tests
